Etihad Airways	No longer accept hunting trophies on its planes
airberlin	Does not allow trophies on board
KLM	In 1998 KLM implemented a full embargo on acceptance and transportation of hunting trophies on the entire KLM network
Virgin Atlantic	Does not allow the carriage of animal trophies on board
Virgin America	Does not allow the carriage of animal trophies on board
Virgin Australia	Does not allow the carriage of animal trophies on board
Emirates	Embargo on CITES Appendix I listed animals and plants; hunting trophies of elephant, rhino, tiger and lion
Lufthansa	Lufthansa Cargo has decided early June not to accept any trophies of the African fauna for carriage from Africa
Brussels Airlines	Ban on the transport of any hunting trophies aboard their aircraft
Qatar Airways	Embargoed all hunting trophies from Qatar Airways flights
Air France	No trophies
British Airways	No trophies of any kind
Delta	Ban shipment of all lion, leopard, elephant, rhino and buffalo trophies worldwide as freight.
IAG Cargo	No trophies
Qantas	No trophies

Singapore Airways	No trophies
Condor	Condor has banned the shipment of all lion, leopard, elephant, rhinoceros and buffalo trophies worldwide as freight
United	Restricts the shipment of lion, leopard, elephant, rhinoceros and buffalo trophies on our aircraft. [The ban on animals] that are not already protected species are effective immediately.
Air Canada	Banned the transport of the Big Five
Austrian Airlines	Do not Transport Trophies
WestJet	Does not carry Big Five trophies
American Airlines	No transport of buffalo, elephant, leopard, lion or rhino trophies.
Air Europa	Ban on the transport of any hunting trophies aboard their aircraft
Binter Canarias	Do not Transport Trophies
CargoJet	Announced on Twitter they will no longer transport trophies of the Big Five
JetBlue	No trophies OR CITES protected species
Aeromexico	With the goal of disincentivizing hunting of animals, we prohibit all transport of hunting trophies on our routes.
Comair	Do not transport trophies
Hawaiian Airlines	Do not Transport Trophies
Swiss International Air Lines	No transport of CITES App I species, and also no lion parts of any kind
CityJet	won't accept hunting trophies on board
LOT Polish Airlines	Does not accept hunting trophies at all
Royal Jordanian Air	Will not transport hunting trophies
Air New Zealand	Air New Zealand refuses to accept hunting trophies of lion, leopard, elephant, rhinoceros or buffalo for carriage on our services.

SriLankan Airlines	the Airline shall refrain from the carriage of game/hunter trophies or any part of an animal killed in the wild or listed as endangered or protected; neither does it endorse nor condone such activities. The Airline is currently reviewing its policy on the carriage fauna and flora, which will be publicised in due course.
THY - Turkish Airlines	Ethical cargo policy bans the carriage of cargo such as hunting trophies, shark fins, raw/processed animal remains, animals for research purposes including primates and laboratory rats, dead animals, infected live animals, all mammals declared to be pregnant, all rodents and all poisonous animals.
Vueling	Does not allow any trophies of any kind on their flights
Aer Lingus	Does not allow transport of trophies on any flights
Ethiopian Airlines	No transport of hunting trophies
Iberia Airlines	No trophies
Finnair	Finnair has placed an embargo concerning hunting trophies, including their skin/hide and all articles made from or containing parts of such animals.
ParcelForce	Dead animals (including preserved animal parts and skins) are prohibited.
FastJet	Does not and will not carry, so called, trophy kills
Cathay Pacific Airlines	No hunting trophies or elephants ivory
Cargo Lux	No lion bones
